

Haiti Trip Report – December 27, 2007

Thank you for your prayers while the brothers were in Haiti. They were encouraged by their trip and arrived home safely.

It was a blessing to see that the Lord is causing the brothers and sisters in the church in Grand Goave to mature in truth. He who began a good work in them is able to perfect it. (Phil 1:6)

During this trip there was a small crusade to evangelise the area, Tapion, where the new church was planted last March. Over three nights, the gospel was preached to the poor, with many of those that responded being children. This is a reminder of Jesus' words, "Truly, I say to you, unless you are converted and become like children, you shall not enter the kingdom of heaven. Whoever then humbles himself as this child, he is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven." (Matt 18:3,4)

While evangelising with the people, it became evident that many did not know what sin was. They did, however, have an understanding of their conscience and doing right and wrong. It is encouraging to know that God is faithful even if people do not have a bible or cannot read. "For when Gentiles who do not have the Law do instinctively the things of the Law, these, not having the Law, are a law to themselves, in that they show the work of the Law written in their hearts, their conscience bearing witness and their thoughts alternately accusing or else defending them." (Romans 2: 14-15) No one is without excuse, since he has given all men a conscience and revealed Himself through what has been made. (Romans 1:19-20)
