I would like to take this opportunity to encourage you and thank you for your prayers for the church in Haiti. We received an update saying the fellowship in Tapion is growing and doing well. There is a Monday night Bible Study to encourage the new believers and there are still more young people coming to the Lord. Many of them are traveling to Grande Goave for services as well. Praise God, He is continuing the work with the new fellowship of believers in Tapion!

I would like to share some verses that challenged me from the second chapter of second Timothy. Paul's exhortation in the first verse sets the stage for the whole chapter: "Be strong *in the grace* that is in Christ Jesus." All that follows hinges on the principle that our strength and hope is in God's saving grace. Paul challenged Timothy with some natural analogies of the Christian walk. "Suffer hardship with me, as a good soldier of Christ Jesus. No soldier in active service entangles himself in the affairs of everyday life, so that he may please the one who enlisted him as a soldier. And also if anyone competes as an athlete, he is not crowned unless he competes according to the rules. The hard-working farmer ought to be the first to receive his share of the crops." (2:3-6) He also charges Timothy to be diligent to present himself "approved unto God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, handling accurately the word of truth." (2:15) These verses encourage us to be diligent to be found by Him in peace, spotless and blameless. (2 Pet 3:14) Working out our salvation with fear and trembling; knowing that it is God who is at work *in us*, both to work and to will for His good pleasure. (Phil 2:13,14) Brethren, may we all "serve one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God." (1 Pet 4:10)
