

He Is – November 01, 2007

The word of God says, "Without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him." (Heb 11:6) I would like to share a few verses on who and what Jesus is, which have encouraged me lately. The first one that stood out to me is found in Revelation chapter 17: "These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord of hosts and King of kings, and those who are with Him are the called and chosen and faithful." (Rev 17:14) Our God is an awesome God, He is clothed with splendor and majesty. Who is there like our God? "He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together." (Col 1:17) "The Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end." (Rev 22:13) Who can explain or grasp the depths of His love and mercy towards those who fear and trust Him? This is our God. The second verse that spoke to my heart is in Hebrews chapter 10: "Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful." (1 Thess 5:24; Rom 8:29) The final verse that has blessed me many times is in Ephesians chapter 2: "For He Himself is our peace, who made both groups into one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall, by abolishing in His flesh the enmity, which is the Law of commandments contained in ordinances." (Eph 2:14,15a) When we abide in Jesus and walk according to His will we have peace which surpasses all understanding. Continually taking everything in prayer and supplication with thanksgiving to God, we can walk in peace in this world. Jesus said to His disciples, "In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world." (Jn 16:33) Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever. He will still "keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Him." (Isa 26:3) Be encouraged brethren, for Jesus is and will give rest to all who are weary and heavy laden and come to Him.
