A Podcast has different entries (or tracks) called episodes, which can be viewed from the Podcast Directory in the iTunes Music Store. If you choose to subscribe to one of the Podcasts then iTunes will

automatically check for new episodes and download the newest one for you when it becomes available. Using a Podcast is a convenient way to keep up-to-date with what's new from the site and makes it easy to synchronize (upload) the content to your iPod.
