In the <u>fear of the Lord</u> there is strong **confidence**, and His children will have a place of refuge. (Pro 14:26)

"Is not your <u>fear of God</u> your **confidence**, and the *integrity of your ways* your hope?" (Job 4:6)

For our proud **confidence** is this: the testimony of our conscience, that in <u>holiness and godly sincerity</u>, not in fleshly wisdom but in the <u>grace of God</u>, we have conducted ourselves in the world, and especially toward you. (2 Cor 1:12)

Such **confidence** we have <u>through Christ</u> towards God. Not that we are adequate in ourselves to consider anything as coming from ourselves, but our *adequacy is from God*. (2 Cor 3:4-5)

And the <u>work of righteousness</u> will be peace, and the service of righteousness, quietness and **confidence** forever. (Isa 32:17)

Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence before God. (1 Jn 3:21)

For we are the true circumcision, who <u>worship in the Spirit of God</u> and <u>glory in Christ Jesus</u> and put <u>no</u> **confidence** *in the flesh.* (Phil 3:3)

For the LORD will be your confidence and will keep your foot from being caught. (Pro 3:26)

For You are my hope; O Lord God, You are my confidence from my youth. (Psa 71:5)

This is the **confidence** which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, <u>He hears us.</u> ...and we know that <u>we have the requests</u> which we have asked from Him. (1 Jn 5:14-15b)

Therefore let us draw near with **confidence** to the throne of grace, so that we may *receive mercy and find grace* to help in time of need. (Heb 4:16)

Blessed is that man who makes <u>the LORD</u> his **confidence**, and does not respect the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies. (Psa 40:4)

Blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD and whose confidence is the LORD. (Jer 17:7)

Now as they observed the **confidence** of Peter and John and understood that they were uneducated and untrained men, they were amazed, and began to recognize them as <u>having been with Jesus</u>. (Act 4:13)
